### Parent Pay

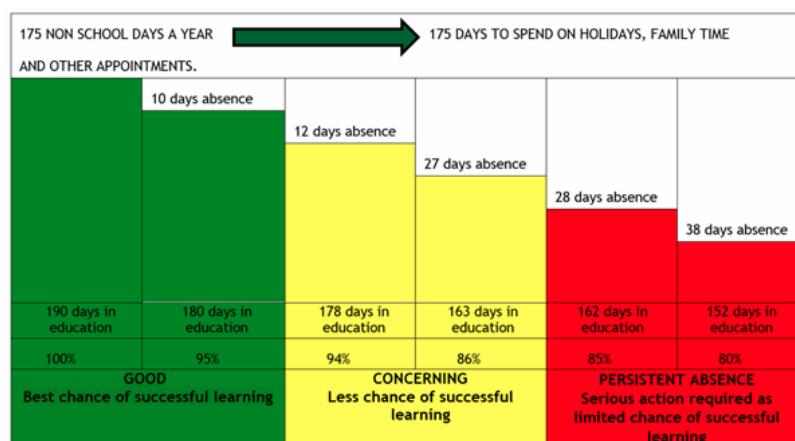
