Our first Year 6 group had a lovely time last week. We welcome back our last group today. On Monday 20th July at 9.30am we will be having our Year 6 Leavers assembly via Zoom. The meeting details will be shared via email later this week.

Reports

This week you will be able to access your child's report. You will see that we have streamlined the report format this year. Due to the circumstances, we are not able to provide accurate end of year judgements about progress and attainment in the way that we would do normally. When the children return in the Autumn we will assess where they are and what needs to happen for them to make progress.

The attendance data is based on your child's attendance up until the 13th March.

If your child is in Year 1 to 6, we will be sharing them with you via Google classroom on Wednesday afternoon after 4pm. It will appear in your child's classwork stream but will only be available to them and cannot be seen by anyone else. This can be downloaded. If your child is in Reception, we will be sharing the reports via Tapestry. It will appear in Memos but will only be available to your child. We are doing it this way rather than sending hundreds of password protected emails.

Next September

School starts on Thursday 3rd September (**Wednesday 2nd September is an INSET**) as usual. We are still finalising the arrangements for September and completing the risk assessment. We do not intend to make any changes to the start and finish times of the day. Years 1 – 6 will continue to have a 'soft start' so parents can drop off in the morning between 8.30 and 8.55am. There will be further communication towards the end of August including videos for the children to show them what to do and where to go when they come back in September as we did for Reception and Year 1 in June. We will share these via Google Classroom and Tapestry but will send you an email to let you know they are available.

We will be moving back to hot school dinners in September. There are some additional logistical challenges to this but we feel that this is a more nutritious and popular offering. Our catering company, ISS, are in the process of producing a revised menu which we will share when we have it.

The children will be expected back to school in their usual school uniform. There will be one slight change. At the moment, the Government advice is that, wherever possible, PE takes place outside. Therefore we would ask that children in **both** KS1 and KS2 have a blue tracksuit (sweatshirt and tracksuit bottoms) in addition to their PE shirt and shorts. Children from Year 3 upwards should also have trainers for PE not plimsolls.

In the Autumn Term there will not be the same number of clubs that we are usually able to offer. We are focusing on ensuring that we can provide breakfast and after school club in the first instance. If you think you will require Breakfast Club or After School Club in September we are asking that you complete a form (available on the website) and email to descostas@monkfrithschool.co.uk so that we can include your child in our planning. We may not be able to offer last minute places in the Autumn Term in the same way as we have done in the past.
