Last week was really positive. The children came in and got straight back into the rhythm of the school day, although I know that lots were understandably very tired by Friday.

In Reception they focused on the children getting back into the routines and started their growing topic. They read Oliver's Vegetables and this week will do some planting! In Year 1 they have been learning about the differences between the seasons, creating some lovely art work as part of their topic, Splendid Skies.. In Year 2 they have been learning about another Dreamer and Changemaker, Ada Lovelace. The children worked through the Hour of Code in Minecraft. These photos are of the work they did creating their own assault courses. They then wrote instructions to help each other complete the course.







In Year 3 they have worked hard with some lovely writing describing a beach setting as well as exploring more about their PSHE focus for this half term: kindness. They had lots of fun in the hall working and playing together (using their topic for last half term about cooperation as well!). In Year 4 they have been finding out about the differences between a myth and a legend while learning about King Arthur as part of their Traders and Raiders topic. They have also been designing Saxon shields. When I popped into Year 5 on Friday they were creating their own amulets from clay as part of their work on Ancient Egypt. Year 6 have been learning about the power of persuasion. They have unpicked the techniques used by successful public speakers such as Barack Obama, Winston Churchill and Greta Thunberg and then written their own emotive speeches.

Covid and Absence

There are no changes to what you should do if your child or someone in your household develops symptoms. The information below is just a reminder:

What are the symptoms of Covid?

The NHS website states that the main symptoms remain:

- A temperature (hot to the touch, over 37.8°C)
- A new continuous cough
- A loss or change in taste or smell

If you are in any doubt or concerned about whether to get a test, the advice is to call 111.

If my child, or someone in my household develops symptoms, what should I do?

Your child should not come to school. Keep them at home and book a test. These are very easy to book now so, please avoid the home test kits, as this adds a delay to getting the result. Everyone in your household should isolate until you receive the result. If you have another child at school, they should not be sent in.

If the test is negative, you can stop your period of isolation and your child can return to school.


If the test is positive, you must inform us straight away so we can identify contacts and ask them to isolate. Please email the Office (even at the weekends). You must then engage with NHS Test and Trace and follow their advice in relation to isolation. We will provide work for your child during this time.


Polling Day
