


If you would like to make a donation to Food Bank Aid, you can drop off anytime between now and Thursday.

Year 3 had their architecture workshop on Monday last week which links to their topic of Flow. They worked in small groups to create bridge structures. All the children did their best to listen carefully both to the man leading the session but also to each other and try out new ideas. At the end of the session, their bridges were dropped from a height to test their strength and stability. It was very tense!




## Science Week 2022

This week has also been Science Week in school. Mrs Ditchburn, who is our Science Subject Champion planned a fantastic series of scientific investigations and experiments for the children in each class.

In Reception they had a great week exploring bubbles. This year from Year 1 to 6 we are looking at the growth of women in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths) careers.

In Year 1 they look at the role of Queen Elizabeth during WW2 (which links to their topic) and investigated how the size of a sails on the wind powered cars they made. Year 2 focused on Zaha Hadid and creating structure. Year 3 looked at Sylvia Earle and how to get water to travel uphill. Year 4 learnt about Dr Gladys West and GPS. They linked this to investigating the keels on Viking ships. Year 5 created rockets and the role of air pressure while also finding about Katherine Johnson. Year took inspiration from Beatrice Shilling and investigated the glide of paper aeroplanes.
