As you may be able to see from the photos, Year 1, have been writing and presenting their weather forecasts to the class.

Year 2 have been learning about deforestation by retelling the story of Slowella the Sloth. I saw some beautiful story plans on Friday ready for their writing next week.

Year 3 have been learning about Pompeii and reading the book, Escape from Pompeii. They were also drawing out their story maps ready for some writing using their senses to describe the eruption of a volcano.

Year 4 have been investigating the parts of the ear and how we hear sound. As part of their learning about sound they have been learning about the artist Wassily Kandinksy.





Just a reminder about Year 5's trip to the Science Museum on Wednesday.

Year 5 have carrying out a range science investigations into the properties of solids, liquids, gases building on their learning from Year 4. I have been really impressed with the children's scientific questioning and enquiry skills!

Year 6 begin their 4 days of SATs tests this week. These are the statutory tests that take place at the end of primary school and it will be the first year they have happened since 2019. Although the last two years have been disruptive and will certainly have affected the children's learning, they have worked so hard, which is all anyone can ask. We are very proud of them!
