**Reception** have been using the photos that their parents sent in to think about what people look like. They have then been starting to create their own self portraits! I will share more next week.

Year 1 had their first coding lessons this term. The children reading the story of Beegu and using this to create their own story maps.

In Year 2 the children were creating their own collages inspired by the work of Giuseppe Arcimboldo. They also investigated the effect of different forms of exercise on their heart rate.

Year 3 were revising their learning about the parts of a plant and then finding out about the features of carnivorous plants.

Year 4 were doing some drama activities as they explored whether Alice would drink the potion in Alice in Wonderland.
