Reception have begun their phonics lessons. This term we have started a new phonic scheme - SuperSonic Phonic Friends. This is a systematic way of teaching children to read and write sounds. Parents should have received a newsletter on Friday afternoon with an update obout what the children have learnt so that you can support at home.

Year 1 were exploring different feelings as part of our PSHE lessons last week. Year 2 were continuing their work learning about the journey of a banana from Costa Rica to the supermarket of choice. Year 3 learnt about tempo and duration in music and began exploring pastel techniques in art.

Year 4 were investigating how materials can change their states by looking at reversible and irreversible changes.

Year 5 were developing their watercolour skills last week in their art lessons. In PSHE they were were learning about the European Convention on the Rights of the Child.

We will be taking part on this national day. Children should wear something red to school. It can be a whole outfit or a piece of clothing alongside their uniform.




I thought that I would share the Year 6 group photo from their Victorian workshop - the children (and staff) looked fantastic!


## SEND Coffee Morning

Earlier this year the government published information on attendance and the expectations on schools and parent to ensure that children attend school regularly. This included further information about the strong correlation between attendance and academic performance:

The pupils with the highest attainment at the end of key stage 2 and key stage 4 have higher rates of attendance over the key stage compared to those with the lowest attainment.

At KS2, pupils not meeting the expected standard in reading, writing and maths had an overall absence rate of 4.7%, compared to 3.5% among those meeting the expected standard.

The overall absence rate of pupils not meeting the expected standard was higher than among those meeting the higher standard (4.7% compared to 2.7%).

If you choose to take holiday during term time, you could face a fixed penalty notice. Details can be found here.
