We were treated to two fantastic performances of the **Reception** Nativity on Wednesday and Thursday last week. The children were brilliant.


Reception also came along to our whole school for part of our assembly on Friday and joined in really well!

FOMS Jingle and Mingle







There are 5 days to go...what will be behind door number 8?




Choir
