Before half term, parents were able to access a webinar that we had purchased about keeping your child safe online. Thank you to the 27 families who logged in and took part. The feedback was really positive!

The statistics show that:

- 42% of 5-12 year-olds used social media (despite being under the minimum age requirement)
- 7 in 10 children aged 5-15 played games online
- 4 in 10 children have come across something online that they would describe as 'nasty' or 'harmful'.
