

## Monkfrith School Summer Term 2023 Newsletter 6



Year 6 spent last week on their Year 6 residential on the Isle of the Wight. Spending 6 days and 5 nights so far away from home when you are 10 and 11 can be really hard! You have to learn different set of life skills but all the adults were really impressed with how well the children did. The schedule was packed - an adventure park, Osborne House, Carisbrooke Castle, the Zoo, a model village, mini golf, bowling, the beach - all while sharing a bedroom with your friends! We were so fortunate with the weather and that meant we were able to make the most of everything we planned. There were lots of great moments but the loveliest thing is how many members of the public or staff at the various locations, stopped one of us to comment on the children's manners.

While we were away, the rest of school also had a busy week! Ms Dunning's assembly on Monday was about World Bee Day. The children learnt about how important they are for the environment and how we can encourage bees to visit our school grounds.

**Reception** went on a minibeast hunt to consolidate their knowledge of minibeast habitats. They found centipedes, woodlice and lots of worms for their wormery. They also had a snail race and found out what snails like to eat.

Year 1 have been story mapping, role playing and retelling 'The Tiger who came to Tea'. In maths they have been learning to recognise half of a shape or quantity. They have also been learning to draw animals using a step by step guide.

Year 5 have been learning about coordinates in both maths and geography. In geography they have been looking at OS maps and in maths have been looking at translation. They have also done a science experiment on solubility.





Year 3 have continued working on their volcanoes this week. They have created paper and paste structures and have painted them. They also wrote a recount of the workshop that they took part in at The Natural History Museum.

In Year 4 the children have been using 'Soundtrap' in their computing lessons to record their poems and add

sound effects. They were also learning about pitch in their science lessons.

Year 2 were finishing their maths assessments as well as learning about different habitats in Science. They were also developing their understanding of tone by using different types of pencil grade.







One of the first things that I did when we got off the coach on Friday afternoon was to go and look at the play equipment that has been installed in KS1. Ms Dunning had been sending me regular photos while I was away but I was keen to see it in real life! The safety flooring is not quite finished as they had overrun on a previous job but hopefully it will be done by Tuesday.

Thank you to FOMS for funding this project - we would not have had money in the government-allocated school budget to do this.
