In **Year 1** the children have been reading the story of Beegu and drawing story maps. They were doing some offline computing about identify, matching and counting objects and sorting materials in Science. What a busy week!



Year 6 were writing setting descriptions about Victorian workhouses using what they have learnt so far in their topic. In Science they were starting to explore adaptation ready to link to their learning about Charles Darwin.

Year 6 will be visiting the William Morris windows at Christ Church later this week.

In **Year 2** the children were combining the work that they have been doing about healthy eating in PSHE, their cutting and chopping skills from Design and Technology and their instructional writing knowledge from English as they made fruit kebabs.



**Year 3** have been finding out why we have a skeleton and about the skeletons of animals and humans. The children have also been starting to create their own non fiction texts about predators.

In **Year 5** the children have been learning about the work of the artist Rosalind Monks who creates detailed and intricate drawings inspired by the natural world.

**Year 5** will be heading to Kingswood in Kent on Wednesday for our 2 night residential. There will be lots of different activities for the children to take part in and we will have a great time! Going away on a trip like this is so beneficial for the children. They develop skills of independence, resilience and for many children, there is a real sense of pride at being able to challenge themselves to be away from home.

They were also doing some drama activities based on their work on Alice in Wonderland.

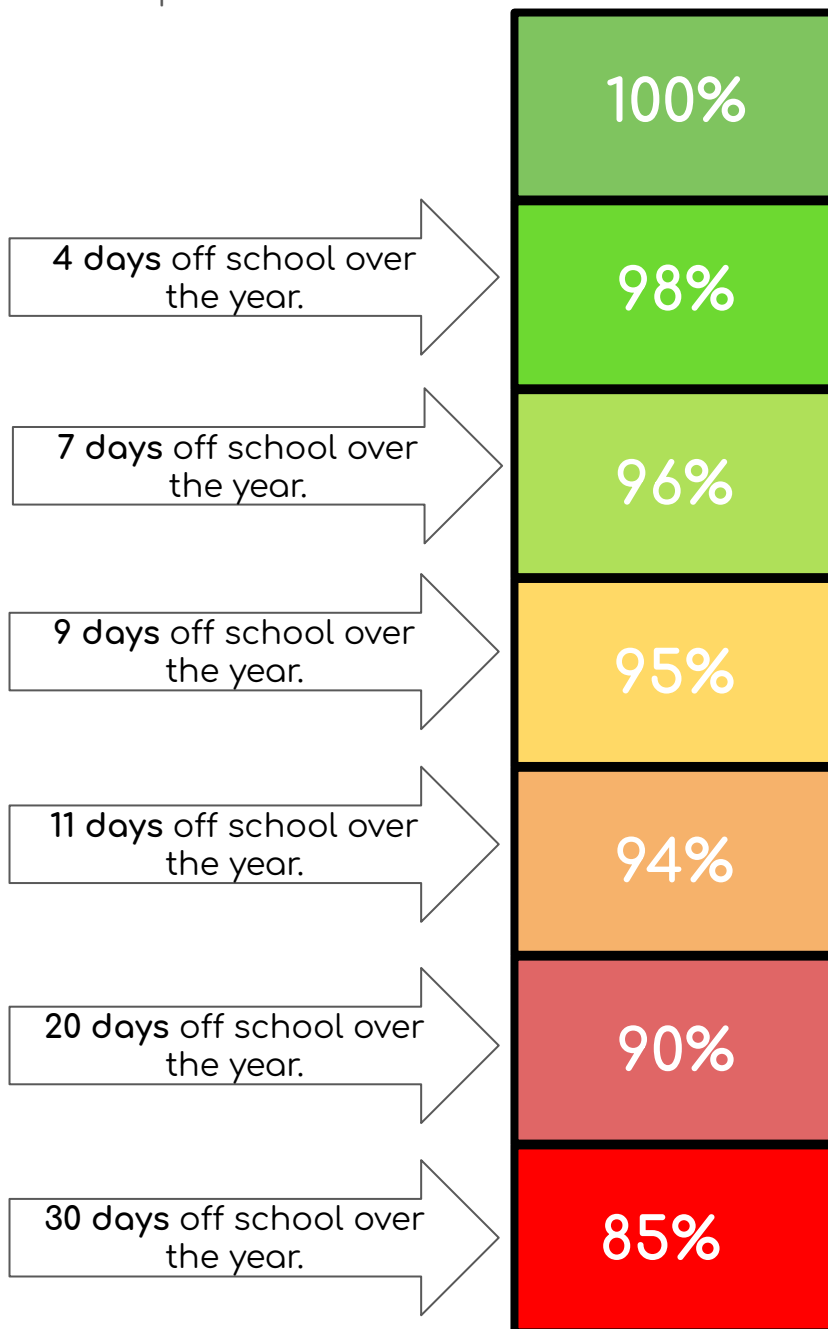


### Just One Tree Day - 13th October 2023
