In Year 4 the children were finishing their Alice in Wonderland writing. They were also investigating what happens when different states of matter are heated and cooled.






Parent Governor Elections

It is a big commitment and the trip would not have been possible without them.











Attendance and Punctuality

Children have the best chance of success if their school attendance is above 96% and we had a great start with attendance last week! Children who attend school regularly and on time are more likely to keep up with school work, develop good habits and important life skills and maintain friendships.

100% 4 days off school over 98% the year. 7 days off school over 96% the year. 9 days off school over the year. 11 days off school over 94% the year. 20 days off school over 90% the year. 30 days off school over 85% the year.

All our lessons build on the day before so if your child misses one day it is like a missing brick in a building. Build the strong foundations of your child's education by ensuring that they are here every day!

Applications received after the 31 October 2023 deadline will be considered after all on-time applications have been processed.






Message from Miss Donaghy:
