It was lovely that so many parents were able to attend the Phonics and Early Reading Meeting on Tuesday last week. If you were not able come along, you should have received the handout in your child's booking on Friday. The first phonics newsletter for Reception parents went home on Friday. All the information is also on the Reception page on the website along with the presentation from Tuesday.

In Year 1 the children were learning about Neil Armstrong. They made posters using facts that they have learnt about his life. They then shared them with the children in Year 3.



In Year 2 they were retelling the story of The Incredible Book Eating Boy. The children also began learning the songs that they will be performing in the Infant Music Festival later this month.

As part of their science learning, the children in Year 4 the children were learning about melting and boiling points and Year 5 were investigating eggs and thinking about why birds lay eggs.

Year 6 were writing about the life of Charles Dickens. This week the children are going to the Ragged School. They will need to leave a promptly so please ensure your child is in school at 8 45 am on Thursday.

Parent Governor Election


There was one nomination by the deadline of last Friday. Luke Louca will join Governing Body as a parent representative.
