There were two school trips last week. On Monday, Year 5 visited the British Museum to look at the Ancient Egyptian galleries. The children had a lovely time and were enthusiastic and asked lots of questions.

Year 2 went to the London Transport Museum on Friday. The children behaved really well and were able to apply lots of their learning that they had already done at school.

In Year 3 the children were exploring electrical circuits as part of their Iron Man topic.

In Year 4 the children were learning more about what it was like to be a Roman as well as finish their draft newspaper reports about Boudicca's rebellion.

On Wednesday they will be going to the British Museum. Whilst we are hopeful of a 3.30pm return, our last few school trips involving the tube have been a little bit late back so please be patient.

Last Wednesday, Year 6S shared some of the learning that they have been doing this half term with KS2 and their families. They told us about the work that they have been doing in geography and ocean currents and we heard some of the fantastic writing that they have been doing in English as characters on board the Titanic. This week it will be the turn of 3DW.

One of the PSHE objectives that the children are taught in Year 1 is about different views and opinions. The children practiced sharing and listening to the ideas of others by discussing their favourite colours, days of the week and books. In Design and Technology they also started looking at their favourite toys and the toys in the past.


