

Monkfrith School Autumn Term 2023 Newsletter 9

In **Reception** last week the children were learning about the topic of Autumn. They were also exploring patterns in maths.

This half term the Year 1 topic is called School Days. Over the term they will think about our school now and the similarities and differences between it and school in the past. They began this week thinking about the concept of past, present and future.

In Year 2, the children began their topic, Street Detectives. They began by revisiting some of the learning from Year 1 about human and physical features. The children have also been practising hard for the Barnet Infant Music Festival in two weeks time. We are one of the host schools and so will be welcoming along 3 other local primary schools on the 17th November. Unfortunately, parents are not able to come along and watch the children perform. We will share photographs after the event.

The topic for the children in Year 3 is called Mighty Metals however they spent last week looking at the artist Alma Woodsey Thomas as part of their Black History Month work. They learnt about her contribution to art and created their own digital prints inspired by her work. In RE the children are exploring beliefs of different faiths.

In Year 4, the children began their topic, I am Warrior, as they found out all about Boudicca. The children also began their new class reader, Alien in the Jam Factory!

In Year 5, they are learning about Ancient Egypt in their topic, Pharaohs! They began by comparing the geography of Egypt to other places that they have studied throughout their time at Monkfrith. They also learnt about the importance of the River Nile. We look forward to the first class assembly of this term - 5LD will be sharing their learning on Wednesday at 9am.

In Year 6, the children began their topic - The Frozen Kingdom. In Science they were exploring ice, using their knowledge of states of matter. The children also started their book for this half term - the wonderful Holes by Louis Sachar.

You can check what housegroup your child if they are not sure, by looking on Arbor.



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
Attendance and Punctuality
