In Reception, they have begun practicing their singing ready for the Nativity in December, as well as building a campfire in the role play area and learning about nocturnal animals. Year 1 has been reading the story of Beegu this week. They then acted it out using puppets and drew a story map about the main events. Year 2 has been using the story maps they drew after reading Paddington to write letters about when he arrived in London.



In Year 3, the children have been learning about different joints and how to make them ready for the next step of their Iron Man mask construction. In their PSHE lessons, they have been learning about rules and laws and why we have them.

If your child has signed up to take part in Year 6 Bikeability please make sure that they have their helmet and bike with them on Monday morning. They can wear leggings or tracksuit bottoms and trainers (usual uniform on top) for the 5 days to make it easier. Your child can leave their bike at school over the week (they will bring them into the building at the end of the day) if that makes it a bit easier.

The children are just about to start practicing their dance for the Barnet Dance Festival, so it is a great time to come along and get involved. It runs on a Tuesday after school (until 4:30 PM) and is free of charge. The Dance Festival is one of my favorite days of the year—it's lovely to join with other schools across Barnet to showcase talent and enthusiasm. This week some of our children in Year 5 and 6 have been taking part in the Primary Mathemtics Challenge. This is inter schoool competition for children aged 9 to 11. We have submitted our results and will find out how we get on in the New Year!





On Wednesday 4B shared their learning so far this year with their parents (and KS2). The children spoke clearly and confidently, and it was lovely to see their enthusiasm shine through. In the classroom, Year 4 has been writing speeches in role as Boudicca and continuing to develop their understanding of Roman poetry. In Year 5, they are learning about Ancient Egypt and have been looking at hieroglyphics and how we can use these to find out about their customs and culture. Year 6 has been writing from the perspective of passengers on the Titanic, thinking about different styles of formal and informal writing.

As the weather turns colder and children are coming in with hats, scarves and gloves please remember to name them so if they are lost or left somewhere we can help return them!

Across all the classes, they have started their contributions to our whole school Christmas display. Each class has a specific part of work on which will contribute to the final effect.
