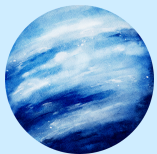

In assembly on Monday, we thought about how finding things hard can just be part of the learning process. We learned about Thomas Edison and his journey in discovering how to make the filament in a lightbulb work. His famous quote was, 'I have not failed. I've just found 10,000 ways that won't work.'



It has been all about teeth this week! In both Year 1 and Year 4, they have been learning about teeth and how to brush properly. In Year 4, we were lucky enough to have a real-life dentist come in to talk to the children—thank you so much to Elica's mum for taking the time to come into school to do this. Year 1 have also been finding out about landmarks in geography. In Reception, the children have been acting out the story of Red Riding Hood and learning about story mapping using words like "Once upon a time," "first," and "next." In Year 3, the children have been exploring timelines and thinking about prehistory as they understand where the Ancient Greeks fit into world chronology.

In Year 2, the children have been looking at algorithms in their computing lessons. In their history lessons, they have been learning about the journey of Amelia Earhart, and in English, they have been writing sentences with contractions, exclamations, and commas.

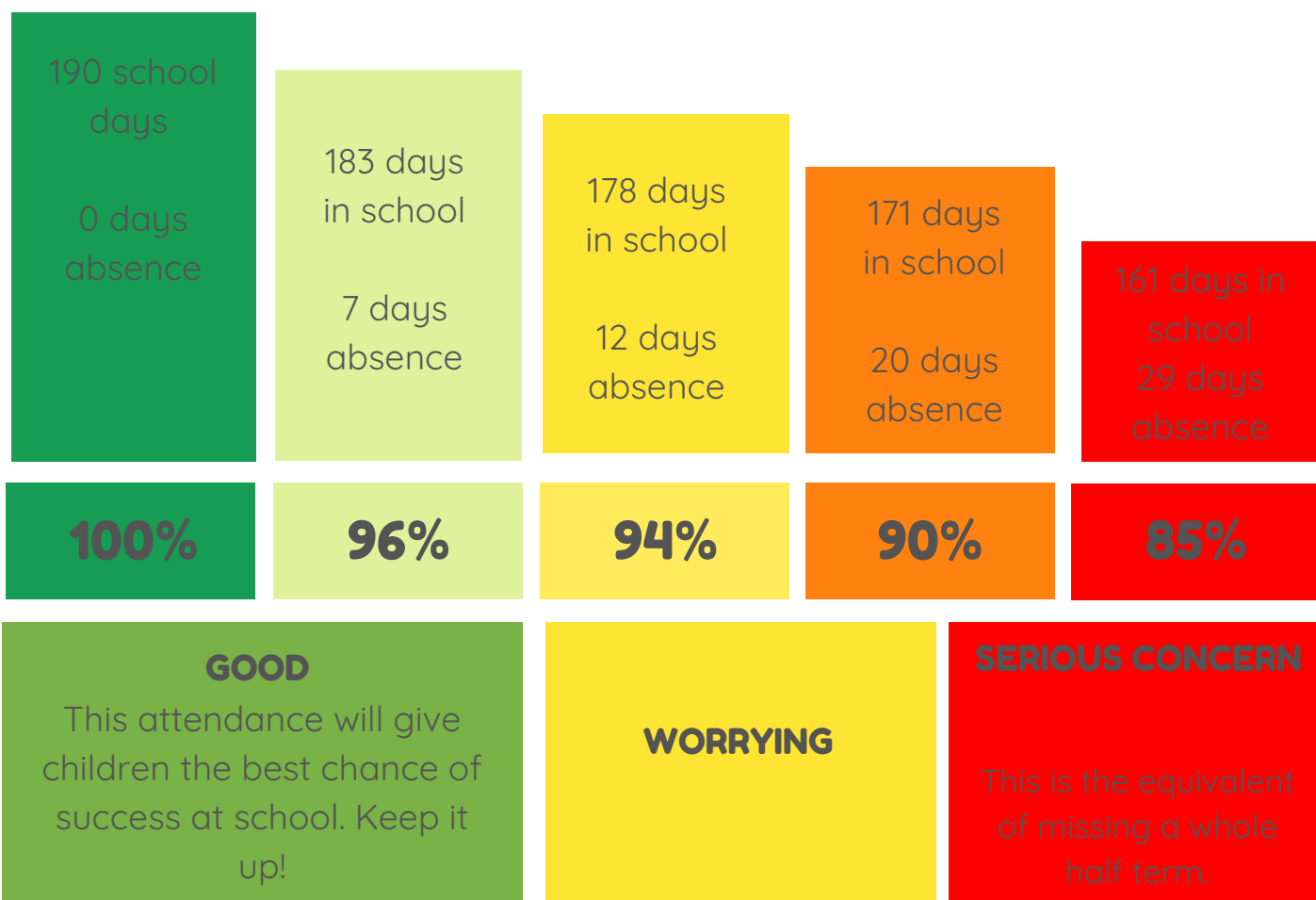
