All the children are coming towards the end of their topics for this half term.

Year 1 have been learning about seasonal changes and creating artwork inspired by the four seasons. In Year 2 they have been evaluating their finished bee-aautiful puppets and writing about Venus Flytrap plants.

Year 3 were out taking and testing soil samples from different parts of the school grounds and writing calligram poems about volcanoes. In Year 4 they have been creating their own artwork inspired by music, planning their biographies about musicians ready to write next week, and learning about how to record sound.

Year 5 have been taking inspiration from the watercolour paintings of artist Georgia O'Keeffe and finding out about different types of farming and land use in geography. They have also started their new class reader: Boy in the Tower by Polly Ho Yen.
